


Instructions for Use

- Before use fully charge battery with approved Lithium battery charger.
- Avoid exposure to heat sources and high voltage, keep out of reach of children, and do not drop the battery.
- Avoid short-circuiting the terminals. Do not attempt to disassemble or expose the battery to moisture.
- Dispose of used batteries safely and properly. Do not throw batteries into fire or water.
- Store the battery pack at room temperature, charged to 40%-60%. Recharge every 3 months to prevent over-discharging.
- Use the battery under specified conditions. Batteries stored for more than one year may experience reduced performance.
- Comply with all regulations for battery transportation, including appropriate packaging, documentation, and labelling.

When using batteries in series:


- Only use batteries from the same batch.
- Ensure the voltage difference between series-connected modules does not exceed 100mV.
- Use low-resistance, high-conductivity connectors.
- Do not connect more than two modules in series

The K2B12100LFP-AU-1 battery is capable of being wired with up to 2 units in series for increased voltage (24V) and up to 4 units in parallel for increased capacity (400Ah). Wiring diagrams are shown below.

The prorated coverage will decrease by 1.38% per month, until it reaches 0% coverage at the end of the warranty period.
